Dear Customer,

As some of you may be aware, CLP EC No 1272/2008 is the new European Regulation on Classification, Labelling & Packaging of chemical substances & mixtures which came into force 20th January 2009.

The legislation introduces throughout the EU a new system for classifying and labelling chemicals based on the UN GHS (United Nations' Globally Harmonised System).

Cornelius understands the importance of this change and our obligations. We have been working together with our suppliers to ensure that the products supplied through Cornelius are compliant with CLP.

In order to fulfill our obligations we are in the process of completing the following tasks:

- Ensuring all substances are classified in accordance with both Directive 67/548/EEC and CLP
- Adding notifications to the C&L inventory for all substances we import into the EU.
- Ensuring all substances are labelled & packaged in accordance with CLP
- Obtaining the SDS for substances with both Directive 67/548/EEC and CLP classifications.
