Stability: Stable

Eye contact: Dust may irritate eyes

First aid procedures:

Skin: Wash with soap and water. If irritation develops, seek medical attention.

Eyes: Flush with water for 15 minutes, if irritation develops, seek medical attention.

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. Administer oxygen or artificial respiration as needed. Contact a physician.

Ingestion: Consult physician.

SECTION VII - SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

Steps to be taken in case material is released or spilled: Remove sources of ignition. Sweep up and remove to disposal container.

Disposal method: Burn in an approved incinerator or use sanitary landfill. Do not incinerate in closed containers. Dispose in accordance with all government regulations.

SECTION VIII - SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION

Ventilation: Local exhaust required.

Respiratory protection (specify type): Wear NIOSH respirator approved for nuisance dust. Comply with OSHA 1910.134.

Protective clothing: Wear protective gloves.

Eye protection: Wear monogoggles suitable for keeping dust out of the eyes.

Other protective equipment: Eye wash station and safety shower in work area.

Precautions to be taken in handling and storing: Store in a cool, dry place. Minimize dust by cleaning up powder accumulations from floor, walls and equipment.
