LOAD

COLOREX MPD

- m-PHENYLENE DIAMINE (solid)
- Coloured solid - Perceptible odour
- Partly soluble in water

NATURE OF DANGER

- Toxic
- The substance poisons: by absorption through skin, by inhalation. Symptoms may develop after several hours
- Decomposes in a fire giving off toxic fumes. Symptoms may develop after several hours
- Irritant effect: on eyes, on skin, on air passages

PERSONAL PROTECTION

- Suitable respiratory protective device
- Goggles giving complete protection to eyes
- Plastic or synthetic rubber gloves. Apron or other light protective clothing. Boots
- Eyewash bottle with clean water
- Two self-standing warning signs, handlamp, warning vest

GENERAL ACTIONS BY THE DRIVER

- Stop the engine
- No naked lights. No smoking
- Mark roads with self-standing warning signs and warn other road users or passers-by
- Keep public away from danger area. Keep upwind
- Notify police and fire brigade as soon as possible

ADDITIONAL AND/OR SPECIAL ACTIONS BY THE DRIVER

- Any action only if without personal risk
- If practicable: use shovel, broom, small collecting container
- Avoid direct contact with substance
- Stop leaks if without risk
- Sweep up spilled substance but avoid making dust
- If substance has entered a water course or sewer or been spilt on soil or vegetation, advise police

FIRE (information for the driver in case of fire)

- Do not attempt to deal with any fire involving the load

FIRST AID

- If substance has got into the eyes, immediately wash out with plenty of water. Continue treatment until medical assistance is provided
- Remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash affected skin with soap and water
- Seek medical treatment when anyone has symptoms apparently due to inhalation, swallowing or contact with skin or eyes
- Persons who have inhaled the fumes produced in a fire may not show immediate symptoms. They must lie down and keep quite still and should be taken to a doctor with this card. Patient must be kept under medical supervision for at least 24 hours

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

- Remove absorbed substance to safe place
- Keep container(s) cool by spraying with water if exposed to fire
- Extinguish with waterspray
