**LOAD****NUOSPERSE FA 182**

- FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS, HAVING A FLASH-POINT BETWEEN 23°C AND 61°C
- Colourless liquid with Perceptible odour
- Soluble in water

**NATURE OF DANGER**

- Flammable
- May evaporate quickly
- The vapour may be invisible. The vapour is heavier than air and spreads along ground
- May form explosive mixture with air, particularly in empty uncleaned receptacles
- Heating will cause pressure rise with risk of bursting and subsequent explosion
- May have irritant effect: on eyes, on skin, on air passages
- Decomposes in a fire giving off toxic fumes. The effect of inhalation may be delayed

**PERSONAL PROTECTION**

- Suitable respiratory protective device
- Goggles giving complete protection to eyes
- Plastic or synthetic rubber gloves
- Eyewash bottle with clean water
- Two self-standing warning signs, handlamp, warning vest

**GENERAL ACTIONS BY THE DRIVER**

- Stop the engine
- No naked lights. No smoking
- Mark roads with self-standing warning signs and warn other road users or passers-by
- Keep public away from danger area. Keep upwind
- Notify police and fire brigade as soon as possible

**ADDITIONAL AND/OR SPECIAL ACTIONS BY THE DRIVER**

- Any action only if without personal risk
- If practicable: use shovel, broom, small collecting container
- Avoid direct contact with substance
- Stop leaks if without risk
- Prevent liquids entering water courses, sewers, basements and workpits. Vapour may create explosive atmosphere
- Contain or absorb leaking liquid with sand or earth or other suitable material
- If substance has entered a water course or sewer or been spilt on soil or vegetation, advise police
- Vehicle carries the following items for use at time of incident
  - Dry Sand, Earth
  - Broom, Shovel
  - Collecting Container

**FIRE (information for the driver in case of fire)**

- Do not attempt to deal with any fire involving the load

**FIRST AID**

- If substance has got into the eyes, immediately wash out with plenty of water. Continue treatment until medical assistance is provided
- Remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash affected skin with soap and water
- Seek medical treatment when anyone has symptoms apparently due to inhalation or contact with skin or eyes
- Persons who have inhaled the fumes produced in a fire may not show immediate symptoms. Patient must be kept under medical supervision for at least 24 hours
- In case of burns immediately cool affected skin as long as possible with cold water

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES**

- Keep container(s) cool by spraying with water if exposed to fire
- Extinguish with waterspray, foam or dry chemical
- Do not use water jet
